

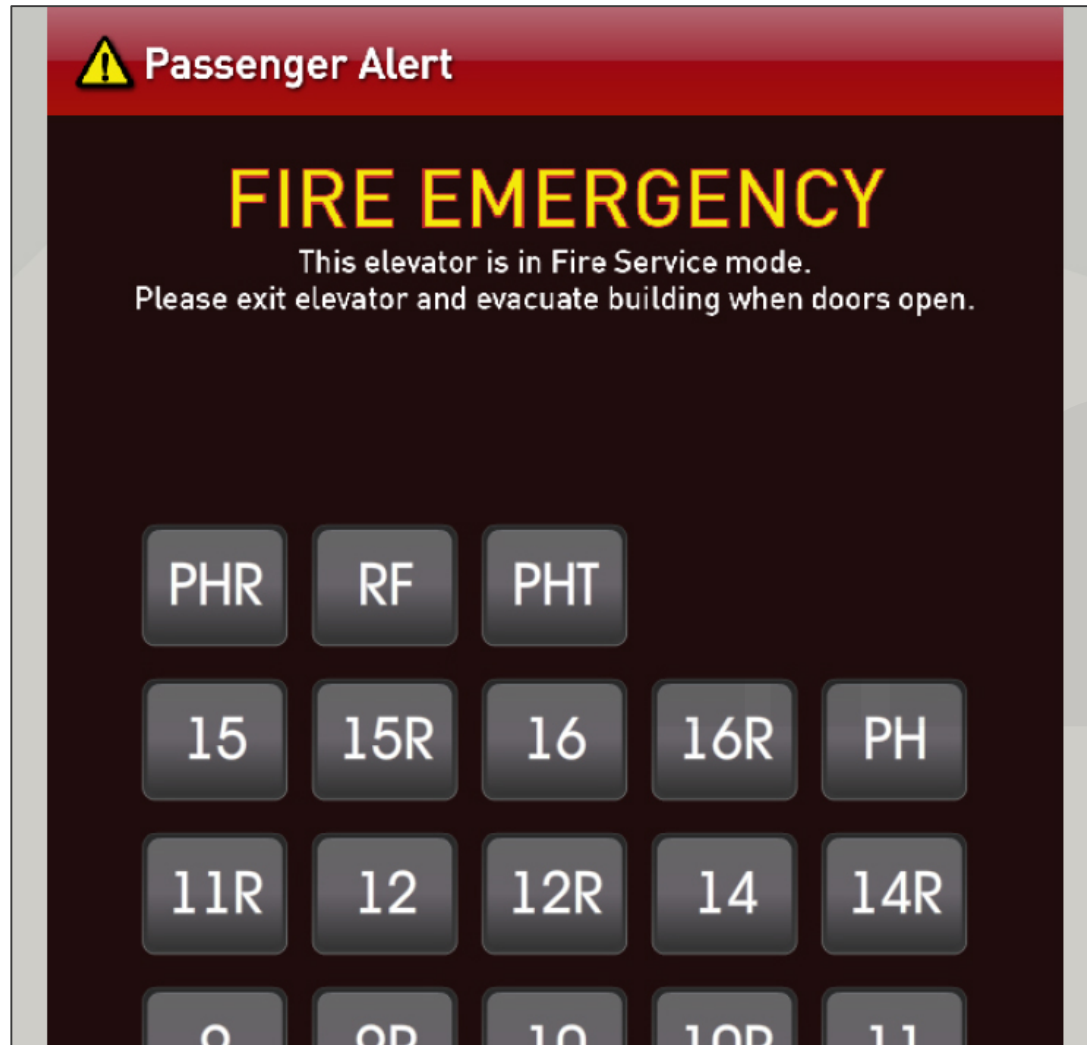
STEP 1

Touch-To-Go touchscreen is running in normal mode.



STEP 2

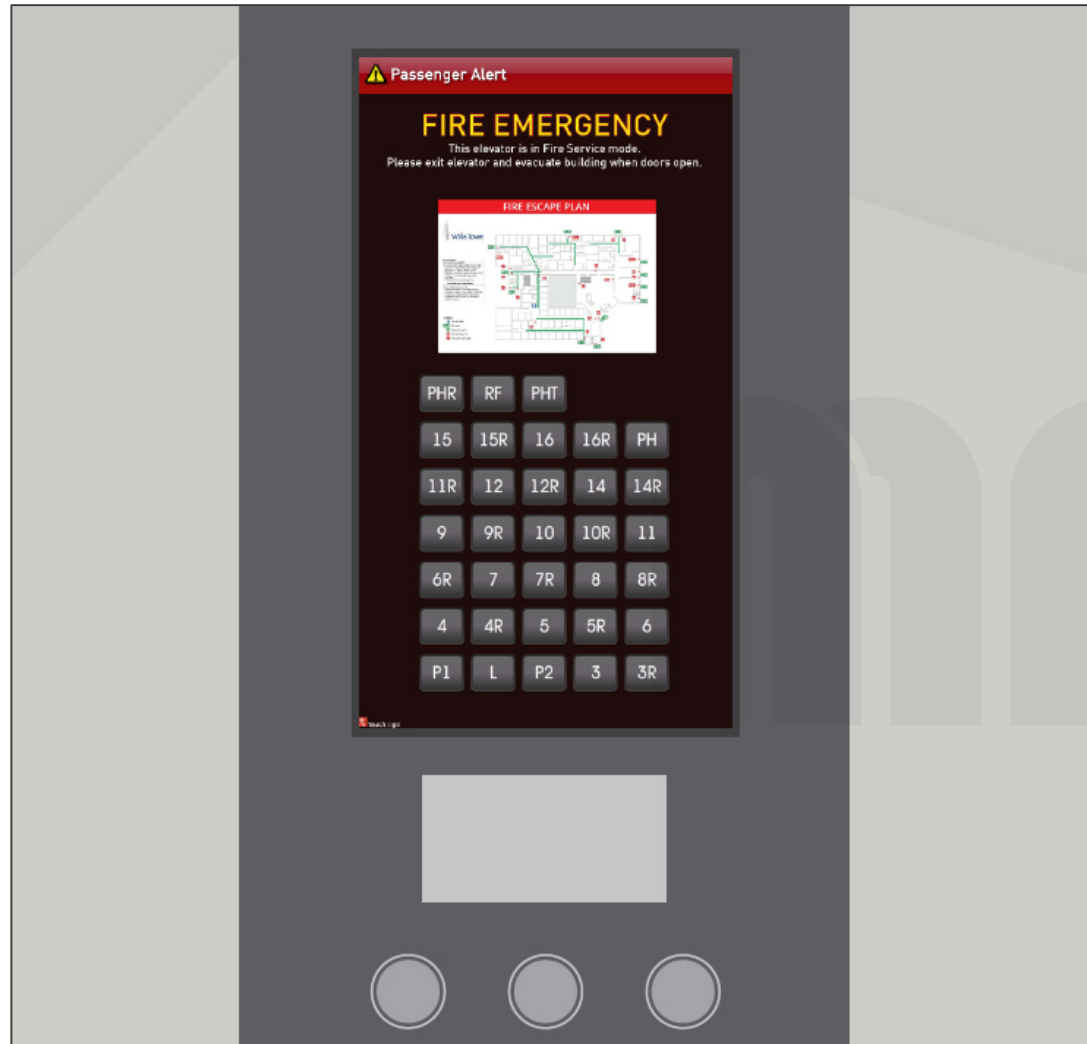
When Phase 1 is activated, the touchscreen turns to dedicated fire service screen.



STEP 3

Fire service screen: Remove all graphical elements to deliver clear, easy-to-use interface.

Message also explains to passengers what is happening.



STEP 4

Floor map for selected floor can be programmed to inform emergency personnel of pertinent info on selected floor.



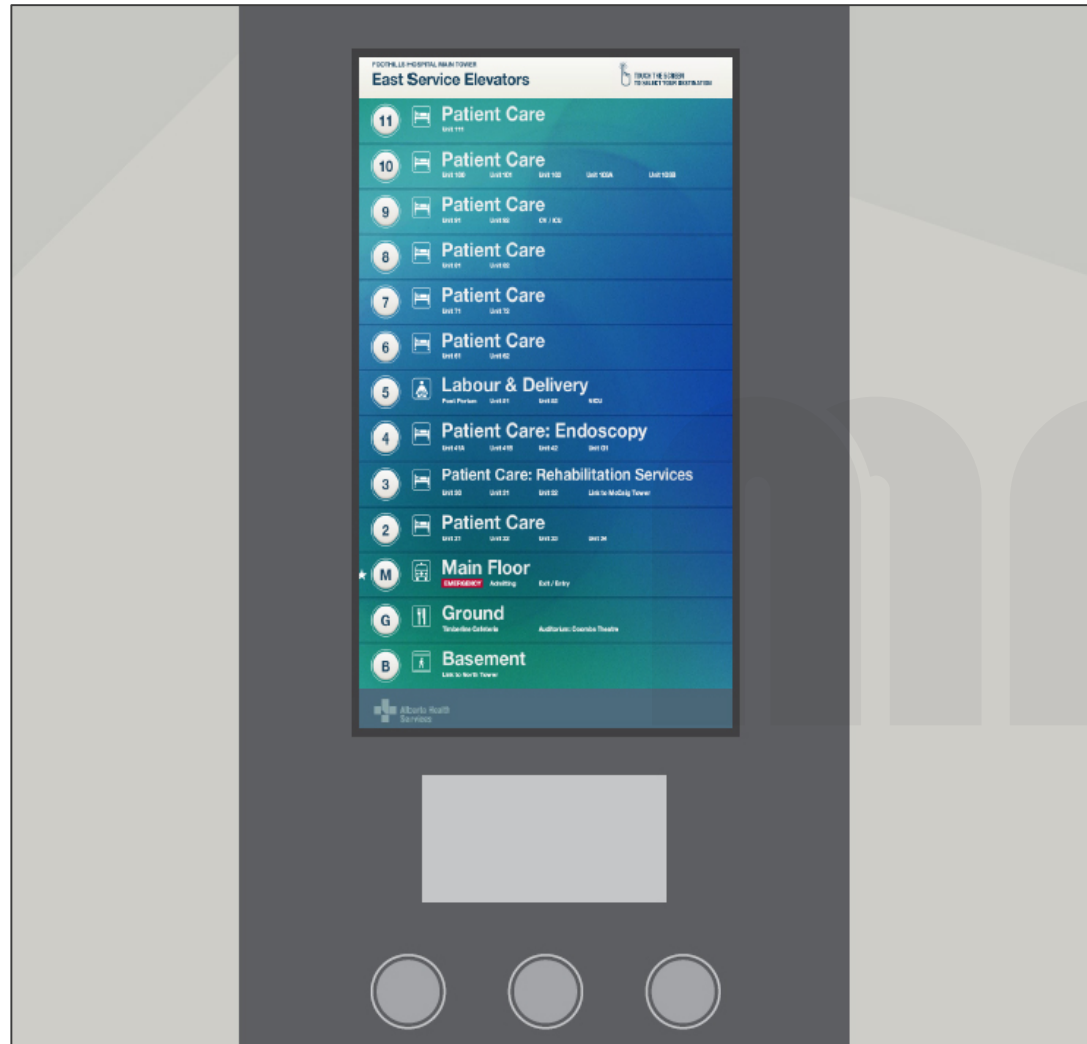
STEP 5

Can be combined with Double Decker Video Verification.



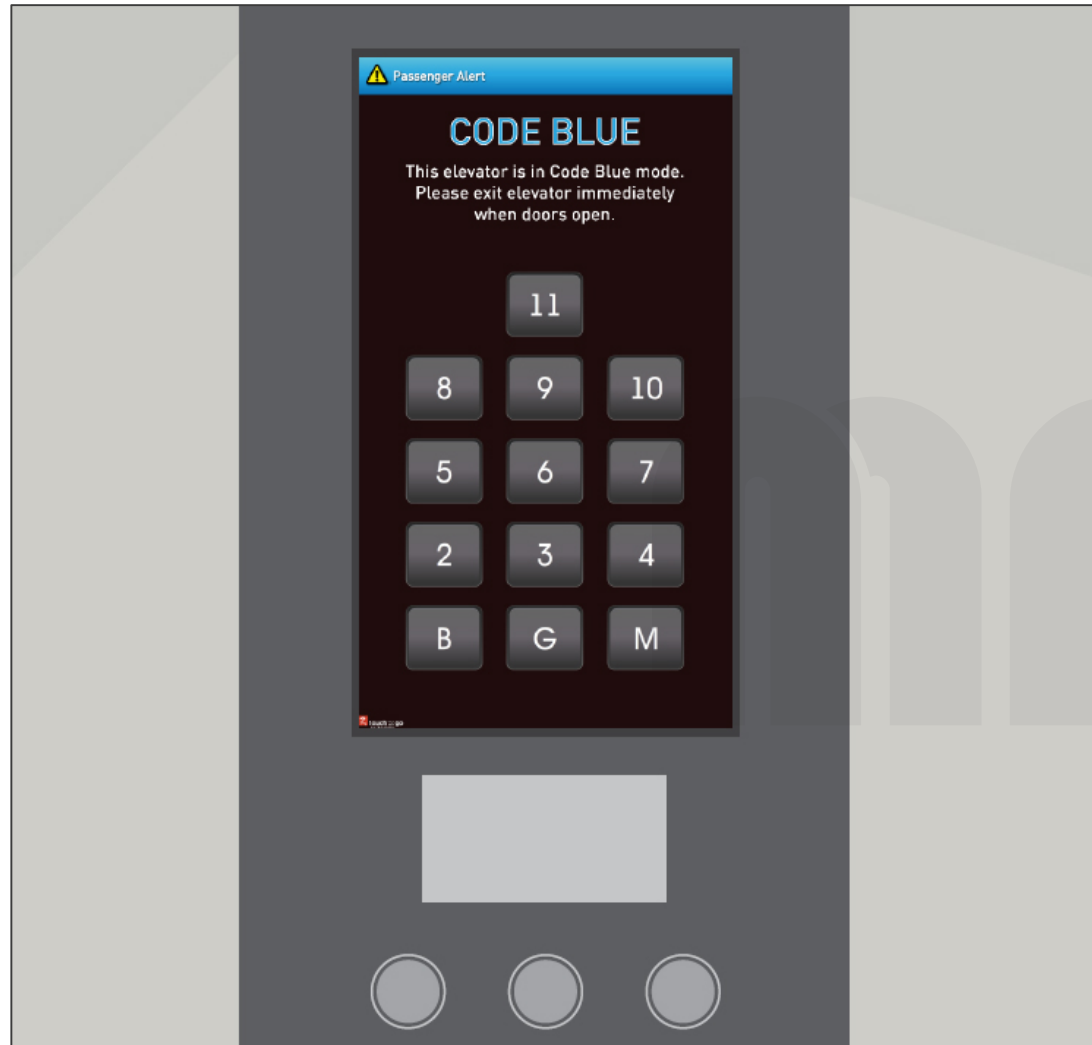
STEP 6

After Fire Service is turned off, the graphic automatically returns to normal.



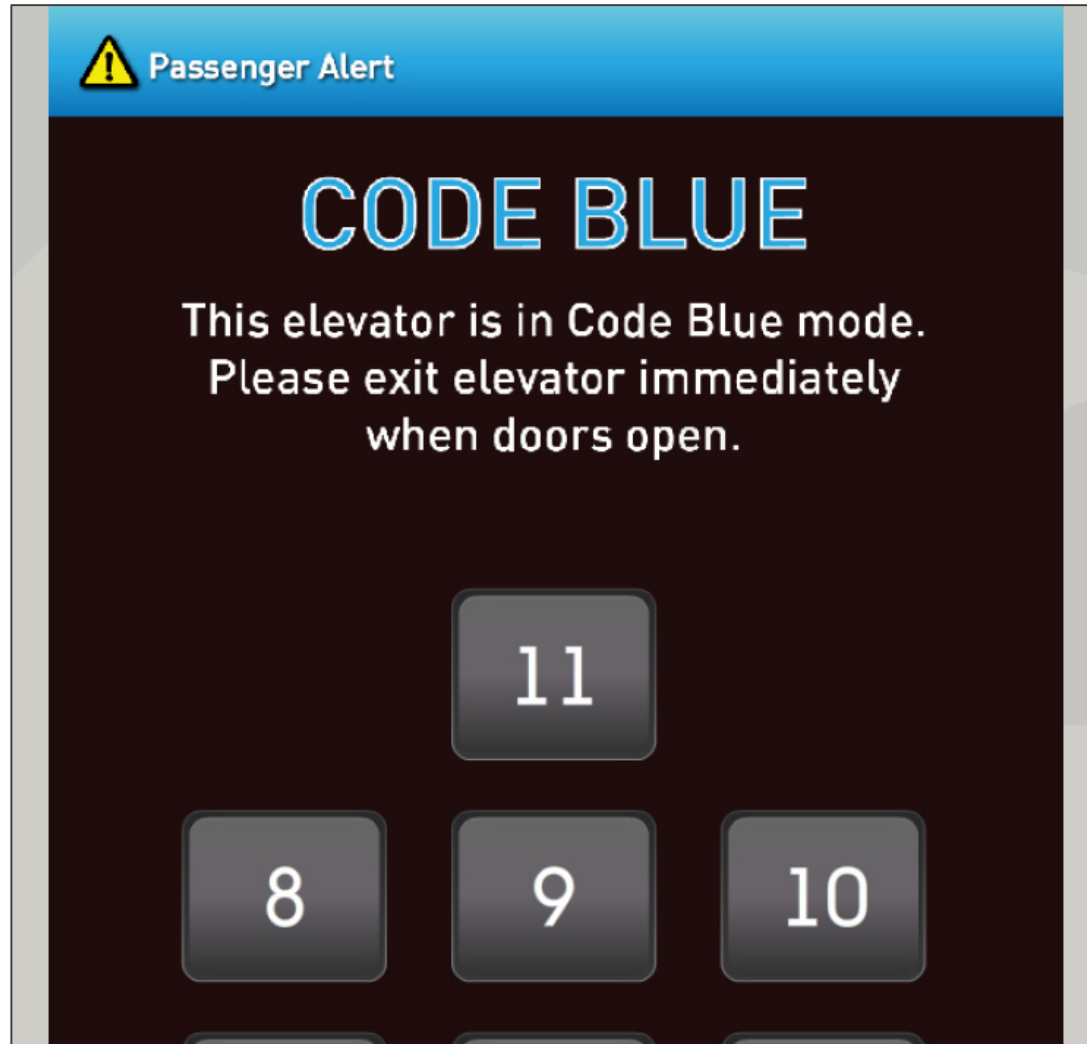
STEP 1

STEP 2

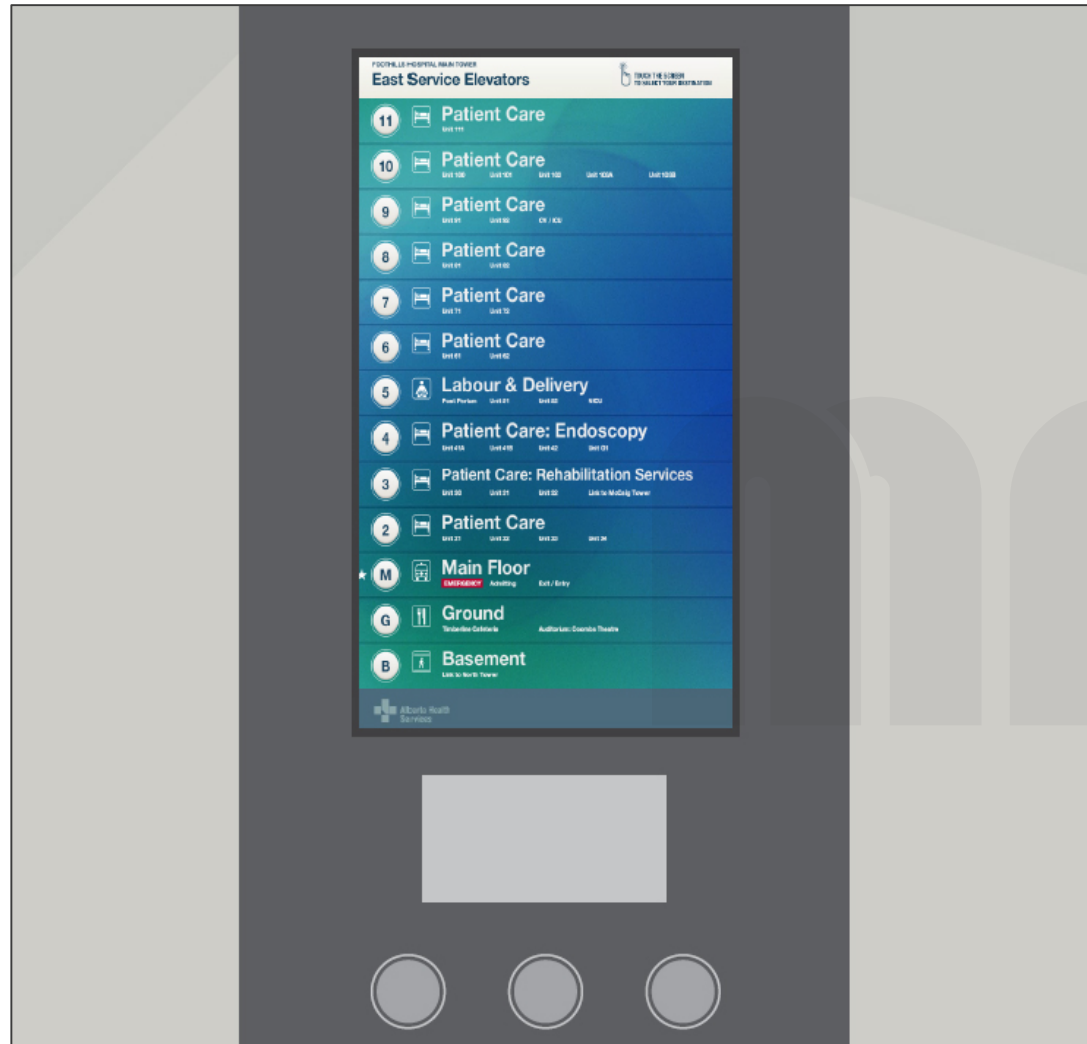
When Code Blue is activated, the Touch-To-Go screen automatically changes to the Code Blue graphic.



STEP 3

Code Blue mode delivers clear, easy-to-use interface.

STEP 4

When Code Blue/Medical Emergency deactivated, the screen returns to normal operation.
